- ☐ Official transcripts of all colleges with degree posted. CSUDH Alums not required, except for all other institutions
 - Sealed copy or electronic copy to be sent to University Admissions <u>admissions@csudh.edu</u> or CSUDH Office of Admissions & Records, 1000 E. Victoria St., Carson, CA 90747
- 2.75 GPA in the last 60 semester units attempted or 2.50 in all baccalaureate and postbaccalaureate course work
- ☐ Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
 - Select two (2) recommenders who can provide a realistic appraisal of your qualifications for graduate-level coursework
 - Submit recommender's email who will receive an electronic Letter of Recommendation form to complete and submit
- ☐ Statement of Purpose
 - Curriculum & Instruction
 - Describe relevant experiences, purpose for pursuing graduate study, and a clear connection to justice & equity in the College of Education mission (no less than 2 pages).
 - Dual Language Learning
