

Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Verification Information

(For informational purposes only. Do not submit this form.)

To determine what documents you are required to submit to the Financial Aid Office, you must first determine your age at the time of your high school graduation.

I was age 18 prior to the date of my high school graduation.

Submit an official high school transcript showing your graduation date

-OR-

I was NOT age 18 prior to the date of my high school graduation.

- Submit an official high school transcript showing your graduation date **AND** one of the following for the parent or *legal guardian listed on your high school transcript.
 - Signed California Tax Return (540 form) for the tax year prior to your high school graduation (Example: Graduated June 2020, submit the 2019 CA tax return)
 - o If your parent or legal guardian did not file a tax return, submit one of the following for the same year as the example shown above.
 - California lease or rental agreement
 - California voter registration
 - California bank account records
 - California utility bill
 - California auto registration
 - If your parent or legal guardian relocated for military purpose, submit a copy of their military records verifying relocation orders from California dated prior to your high school graduation or its equivalent AND at least one of the documents listed above for a period that **predates** the relocation orders.

^{*} A legal guardian is one who is appointed through the courts.
