

IDS/Pace Schedule -- Spring 2025

To register for classes for spring 2025, you must

- Call the IDS/PACE office (310-243-3640) and make an appointment to see your IDS/PACE advisor
- Review your IDS Major or Minor in “Academic Requirements” on misused
- Meet with your advisor to assure that you are continuing to fulfill all requirements for graduation
- Complete the online sexual assault training

After your advising is complete, and your academic advisor has lifted the hold on your registration.

- Know the date when you can first register—sometime on or after Monday, Oct. 14, 2024
- Register by Toro Web as soon as you are able (help us avoid having classes cancelled!)
- PAY YOUR FEES ON TIME, OR YOU WILL BE DROPPED FROM ALL YOUR CLASSES!
