WHAT: We are looking for a student interested in gaining some hands on research experience on an exciting study. The study is 'Gay Boy Talk' and we have collected interview data from 24 friendship pairs (young gay men's best friendships with other young gay men and with heterosexual females) to explore how they discuss sexual health topics. We are also investigating how their discussions regarding sexual health issues may affect their risk behaviors.

CSUDH students working on this study in the past 2 years have been involved in presenting data at student research day and also at regional and national conferences. This is a great way to add research experience to your CV especially if you are considering graduate school.

WHO: We are also interested in adding bright, hard-working, and highly analytical students to the research team in general. Students in Sociology, Psychology, and Anthropology are preferred.
